ALIMZHAN BEKMAGAMBETOV is a head of the research department of Kostanai branch FSBEI HPE "Chelyabinsk State University" (Kostanai, Kazakhstan), a member of the Oxford Academic Union, winner of the International Open Competition "Scientist of the year - 2015" in the "Social Sciences" category, for the "Criminal Law, Criminology" field, Professor of Law department, Candidate of Law.

Alimzhan Bekmagambetov was born on October 23, 1979 in Kostanai region; he graduated from Kazanbasskaya high school cum laude.

He has two higher educations with a specialization in "Law" (Kazakh Institute of Law and International Relations, cum laude) and in "Jurisprudence" (Chelyabinsk State University).

His promotion track consists of the following positions: an ordinary teacher, head of the Law department of Kostanai branch "CSU", a chief scientific associate of Forensic Enquiry Centre of the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Kazakhstan (Astana), a press secretary of akim of Kostanai region.

Alimzhan Bekmagambetov was a member of the Council of Young Scientists of Kazakhstan, the Republican Association "Youth Parliament", leading the youth non-governmental association, realized 5 sponsored socially important projects. Alimzhan Bekmagambetov was a speaker of the round table "Development of youth parliamentarianism in CIS and SCO". Now a head of the Scientific Advisory Board of the regional Assembly of People of Kazakhstan, and a member of Educational advisory board of lecturers of a regional center for retraining and training of civil servants.

The holder of the refresher training certificates at the Academy of Public Administration under the President of Kazakhstan, training in Germany for experts in the field of youth policy, and certificate of participation in the work of international workshop devoted to the issues of people's rights and freedoms in Kazakhstan and Germany. He was awarded to grateful letters and certificates of appreciation of Chairman of the Party, the President of the Republic

of Kazakhstan, Commander in Chief of the Air Defense Forces of Armed Forces of the Republic of Kazakhstan, akim of Kostanai region, and akim of Kostanai.

Speaker and member of the OSCE Review Conference (Astana, 2010), the Euro-Asian Law Congress (Yekaterinburg, 2011), the Russian Congress of Criminal Law (Moscow, 2011), as well as conferences on the basis of the Kazakh Humanitarian Law University (Astana), Moscow State Law University, the Academy of the Investigative Committee of the Russian Federation (Moscow), a branch of the Russian State University of Justice (St. Petersburg), Saratov State Academy of Law (Saratov), Ural State Law University (Yekaterinburg), The Volgograd Academy of the Russian Internal Affairs Ministry (Volgograd) and others.

Author and co-author of more than 100 works, including 5 monographs (some of them were published in Germany (1) and Poland (1)), 3 criminal law of Kazakhstan textbooks, 10 tutorials and over 80 articles published in collections of conferences and leading peer-reviewed journals in Kazakhstan, Russia, Poland, Canada on subject matter of counteraction of crime connected with human traffic.

"Criminal Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan" textbook has the particular importance. The textbook was published in early 2015 and co-authored, edited by Honored Scientist of the Russian Federation, "the Knight of Arts and Sciences", academician of the New York Academy of Sciences, the European Academy of Law, Honorary Professor of the European Academy of Law, Doctor of Law, professor, academician V. Revin. This work was the first book in Kazakhstan devoted to doctrinal interpretation of the new Penal Code of the country.
